## Scholarship Information

Thanks to the generosity of the McLarty Auto Group, scholarships are available for a prospective camper that participated in the National School Lunch Program (free/reduced meals) during the school year prior to the start of camp

- A scholarship may only be applied towards registration for a household with at least one camper 5-10yrs of age
- If you are accepted for a scholarship, you will only owe \$2 per day of camp requested and it is possible to request four days of camp
- You may request up to four days of camp per household during camp registration (different form that you will access later)
