Eco Olympics

June 7-11; June 28 - July 2; July 19-23; August 9-13

Faster. Higher. Stronger. Animals have different roles to play in their ecosystem. Campers will learn about some of the fastest runners, swimmers, and fliers and the extreme lengths some animals go to survive.

Conservation Connection

June 14-18; July 5-9; July 26-30; August 16-20

Many animals that live in zoos are threatened with extinction. Campers will hear the inspiring stories of how zoos have saved animals, meet some of the amazing endangered animals at the zoo, and discover what they can do at home to help save wildlife from extinction.

Zoo Discovery

June 21-25; July 12-16; August 2-6

Scholarship Information

Thanks to the generosity of the McLarty Auto Group, scholarships are available for virtual camp. Here are the guidelines:

- Prospective camper must have participated in the National School Lunch Program (free/reduced meals) or received financial aid related to their schooling during the semester before the start of camp
- Completion of the form does not guarantee entry into a camp
- A scholarship may only be applied towards registration for a household with at least one camper 5-10yrs of age
- A \$2 payment per camp is required with the scholarship covering the rest of the cost of camp registration
- You may request up to four weeks of camp per household during this camp season
